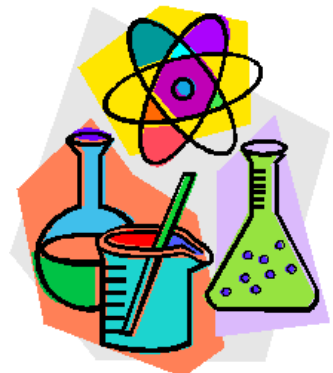

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Program Policy and Guidelines

CLASS SIZE:

- ❖ Class sizes are limited and will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.
- ❖ Classes may be canceled if the minimum size requirement is not met.
- ❖ If your student is not able to be placed in a class due to size, you will be notified and your check shredded.

REGISTRATION:

- ❖ Registration forms **MUST** be signed on electronic registrations.
- ❖ Please complete a **separate** registration for *each student*.
- ❖ Place all payments in an envelope clearly marked “**AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS**” and return it to your child’s homeroom teacher by **Monday, December 12, 2016**. Please note the student’s first and last name in the memo section of all checks!!

PAYMENT:

- ❖ Make checks payable to **Union Elementary PTSO**. No cash can be accepted.
- ❖ Please write a **separate** check for *Each Student*.
- ❖ PTSO reserves the right to remove a student from class if fees are not received in full or check is returned for insufficient funds. **There will be a \$25 service fee for any checks returned from the bank.**
- ❖ **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ONCE A CHILD IS CONFIRMED IN A CLASS.** Confirmations will be sent as soon as possible once registration is closed via the email address you list on the registration form.

CLASS SCHEDULES:

- ❖ **Classes Vary. Please Check Each Class Carefully!** See class descriptions for day, time, and length.
- ❖ **PLEASE, REMIND YOUR CHILD OF THEIR CLASS ON THE DAYS THEY ARE SCHEDULED.** Due to the varying schedules, we cannot be responsible to remind students of the classes they have signed up for.
- ❖ **ALL STUDENTS REPORT TO THE CAFÉ AND WILL BE PICKED UP BY THEIR INSTRUCTORS!**
- ❖ Please have an alternate plan in the event that the class is unexpectedly canceled. Discuss plan with your child.
- ❖ Classes cancel if school is canceled for any reason on that day.
- ❖ Instructors will inform parent/guardians of rescheduled dates if a class is canceled.
- ❖ **CHILDREN MUST BE PICKED UP PROMPTLY AFTER CLASS.**

DISCIPLINE POLICY

The Lakota Student Code of Conduct is to be followed during the after school classes just as it is during the regular school day. The Lakota discipline policy can be found in the Lakota Elementary Handbook. If a child is participating in the after school program classes and is not behaving according to the discipline policy, including disrupting the class so that the other participants are not able to get the most out of the class that they can, the parent will be notified and the student will be withdrawn from the class. There will be no refund of the course fee.

Late Pick Up Policy

There is a five minute grace period for picking up your child. If a child is between 6-10 minutes late being picked up, your child will have to miss the following week of the program. If your child is between 11-15 minutes being picked up, your child will have to miss two weeks of the program. If your child is more than 15 minutes late being picked up, your child will be removed from the program.

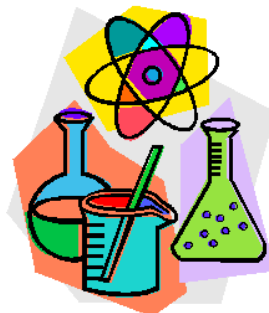
